Attendance at School

I would like to remind parents at the start of the academic year about procedures for reporting absence and of the school attendance policy.

The ethos of the Christ Church Schools is one of a happy, caring environment. We believe that children learn best when they are happy and relaxed. All staff show concern and care about each child's welfare and provide a supportive and nurturing environment. As attendance is crucial to effective learning and the continuity of learning experiences the school places great emphasis on this and asks parents for their support.

All children should be in school everyday unless unwell or at an appointment that the school has prior notification of. Parents should contact school on the first day of absence to report the reason and keep in regular contact with the school should the period of absence continue. Where there is no communication around the absence this naturally causes welfare concerns for the school who has a duty to ascertain the whereabouts of children. If no communication has been received, the school will contact parents via text or telephone.

Punctuality is also monitored by the school. Please consider how arriving late regularly may impact on your child's ability to settle to learning and how they may feel walking in late to a class that is already underway. Understandably there will be the odd occasion, where this is unavoidable e.g. your car breaking down, however please do try not to fall into a pattern of regular lateness.

A polite reminder that holidays should not be planned or taken in school time unless there are exceptional circumstances. An application must be made to the school to take a child out of school during term time.

Parking

As you are aware, parking can be difficult especially at peak drop off and pick up times. Your continued support with considerate and safe parking is appreciated. We ask parents to be mindful of our neighbours and pedestrians using the pavements. We also ask, that parents do not drive up the lane unless it is an emergency. Thank you for your co-operation.

Polite Reminder

Please remember to inform the member of staff on morning gate duty or the School Office if your child/ren are to go home with another pupil, or be collected by an adult who doesn't usually collect them.

We will not release pupils unless messages have been received from parents/carers. Please ensure you inform the school office by **2:30pm** to allow the message to be delivered.
