Apologies for the Confusion-Lunch Menus

I'd like to sincerely apologise for the mix-up with the menus this week. It appears that the version provided to me—which indicated that the week beginning 08/09/25 would be Week 1—differed from the version sent to the kitchen team. I'm very sorry for this miscommunication, and I've already discussed the issue with the catering management team during a meeting today to ensure better alignment moving forward. I can confirm that next week will be WEEK 3 on the attached menu.

Additionally, I'm aware that some parents have raised concerns regarding portion sizes. This was also addressed in my meeting with ABM Catering's management. They explained that all portion sizes are required to meet strict government guidelines, which are carefully calibrated and increase slightly for pupils in upper Key Stage 2. Meals are served using measured utensils to ensure consistency and compliance with these standards.

That said, I've personally observed the lunch service this week and taken photos of children with their meals as they left the hatch, to better understand the presentation and quantity being served. I've also added several parent lunch dates to the school calendar. These events offer a valuable opportunity for parents to spend time with their child in school and to see the food and service methods firsthand.

I will continue to monitor the lunch service closely, especially the specific meals that have been highlighted to me by parents. Your feedback is important, and I'm committed to ensuring that every child receives a nutritious and satisfying meal each day.


Friday 21st November- Mop up flu vaccine for those children who were absent on the day.
