We look forward to welcoming you and hope you enjoy this meaningful experience with your child.



I understand that for working parents attending such events can be difficult. Please do not worry. All children will be involved in the session, regardless of whether they have an adult present.


The session will begin at 2.00pm in the school hall and last approximately an hour. At the end of the session children and siblings will be able to leave early.




# **Book Fair**


