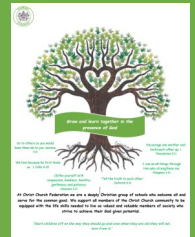

We look forward to welcoming you and hope you enjoy this meaningful experience with your child.

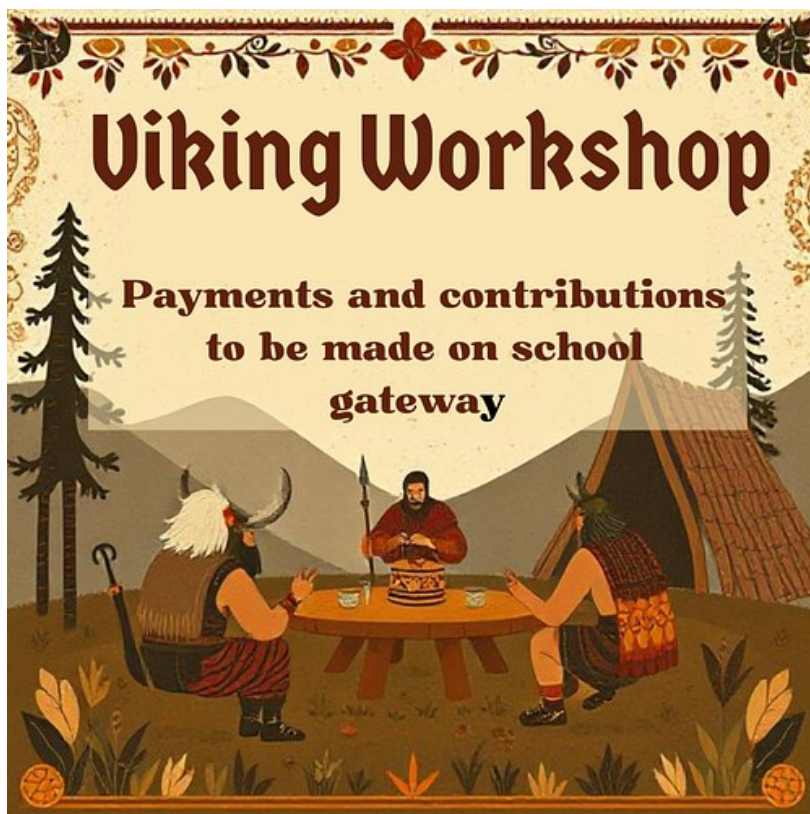
