### **Y2 visit to Santa Safari-West Midlands Safari Park –Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2023**

On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December, Year 2 will be visiting West Midlands Safari Park where the children will take part in a Santa Safari interactive day. They will experience a snow covered Winter Wonderland, the drive through safari and visit Santa (with a photo and gift to take home). They will travel by coach, leaving school promptly after registration and returning for the end of the school day.

Uniform must be worn and please ensure your child wears a waterproof coat/jacket and sensible shoes. No pocket money is required.

As part of the Universal Free School Meal scheme for all Infant children, a free packed lunch can be provided. Please inform the school office by Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> November if you require a lunch to be provided. If you wish to provide your own we ask you to provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles and no nuts please).

Please note that school will not administer travel sickness tablets unless they are prescribed by a Doctor and a written consent form completed (available from the school office).

The cost of the visit is £20.80 per child (coach and activities). Voluntary contributions are therefore now requested. Although contributions are voluntary, should we not receive sufficient funds to cover the cost of the visit, the visit may not be able to go ahead. Payment and consent to be made through School Gateway no later than Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> November.
