Reminder RE: Importance of collecting your child on time from Nursery.

Morning Drop Off

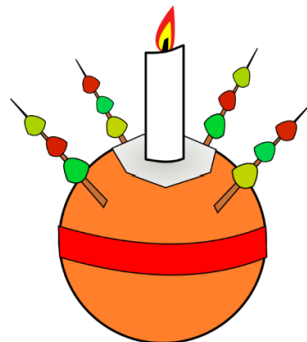
