Pupils try their hand at politics

Young students have become the politicians of the future after they visited the nation's capital to take part in a mock debate.

Year six students of Christchurch Junior School, on Woodcot Road, Tottenhall Wood, visited London on January 10 to better understand the nation's democratic process.

As part of the trip, 54 students attended the Houses of Parliament where they took part in an interactive workshop, a learning seminar and a mock debate where they debated a set topic. A spokesperson for the school said: "The children visited parliament where they took part in the activities centre and also had a tour around the House of Lords.

"It was amazing, the children really loved it, they also took part in a mock debate where they learned more about the democratic process. We had amazing feedback from the parents who said that the lesson really stuck with the children."
