Temporary changes to behaviour policy upon school reopening (COVID-19)

- 1) In order to adhere to social distancing, key worker children will enter and exit the school grounds through the car park gate. The Year 6 children through will use the normal school gate.
- 2) Children will go straight to their designated room and wash their hands on arrival. They will not socialise with children from other groups and will maintain social distancing.
- 3) Children are to wash their hands before eating. This should be done with hot water and soap which are available in the toilets. Paper towels will be used to dry hands.
- 4) Children are not permitted to mix with another bubble group at any time. This includes lunchtimes and break times.
- 5) Two bubble groups will be outside at the same time. They must not mix.
- 6) Children must use the tissues provided in each classroom to 'catch it, bin it, kill it'. They must place used tissue in the designated bin.
- 7) Children must make an adult aware if they feel they have any symptoms feel unwell.
- 8) Children should not bring items in from home (with the exception of a water bottle and lunchbox). All equipment (pencils, rulers etc) is provided and not shared between children/ classes.
- 9) Children's contributions in class to be made from their desks where possible- movement around the classroom should be kept to a minimum.
- 10) Children must take a responsible and respectful attitude towards their conduct regarding coronavirus.
- 11) Children must follow the instructions of the adults in school at all times.
- 12) Children will not be allowed to play football/netball as this encourages them to break social distancing.
- 13) Failure to follow these rules may result in your child's place being removed. This is for the safety of all children and adults on site.
