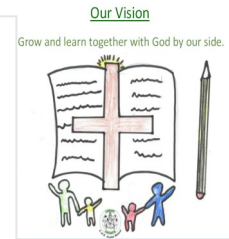

Lunches

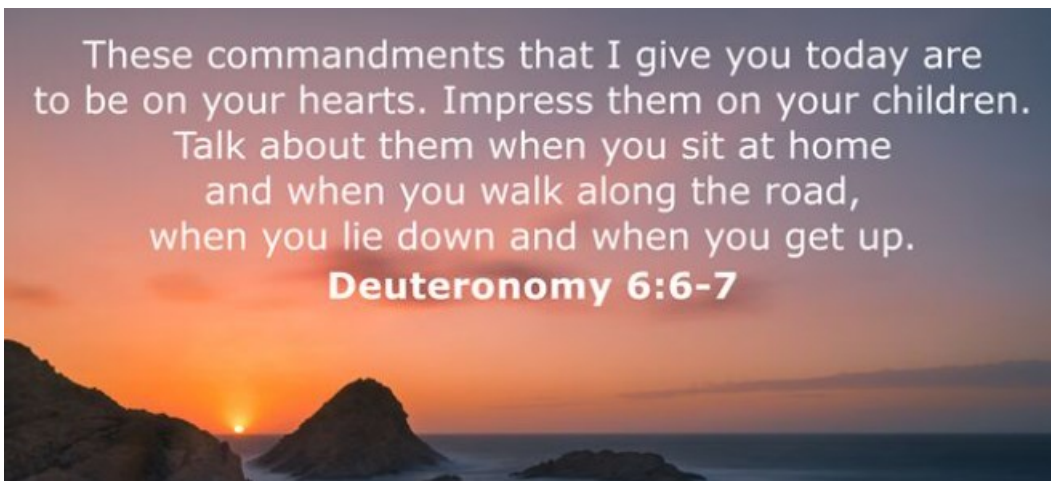

when you lie down and when you get up.

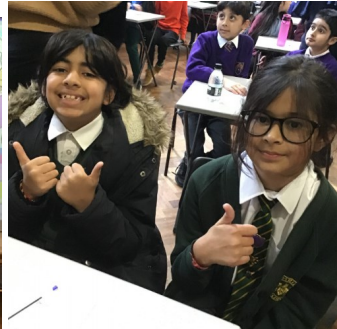
