Temporary changes to behaviour policy upon school reopening (COVID-19)

- 1) In order to adhere to social distancing children will enter and exit the school grounds at staggered start and finish times.
- 2) Parents will not be allowed to enter the building and should maintain at least 2m distance between themselves and school staff on duty on the playground.
- 3) Children will go straight to their designated room and wash their hands on arrival. They will not socialise with children from other groups and will maintain social distancing.
- 4) Children are to wash their hands before eating. This should be done with hot water and soap which are available in the toilets. Paper towels will be used to dry hands.
- 5) Children are not permitted to mix with another bubble group at any time. This includes lunchtimes and break times.
- 6) Two bubble groups will be outside at the same time. They must not mix. Children must stay in the area assigned to their group.
- 7) Children must use the tissues provided in each classroom to 'catch it, bin it, kill it'. They must place used tissue in the designated bin.
- 8) Children must make an adult aware if they feel they have any symptoms or feel unwell.
- 9) Children should not bring items in from home (with the exception of a water bottle and lunchbox). All equipment (pencils, rulers etc) is provided and not shared between children/ classes.
- 10) Children must follow the instructions of the adults in school at all times.
- 11) The children must only use the toilets assigned to their group.
- 12) During lunch the children must remain seated at the table until all of their group have eaten and they are ready to leave as a group.
