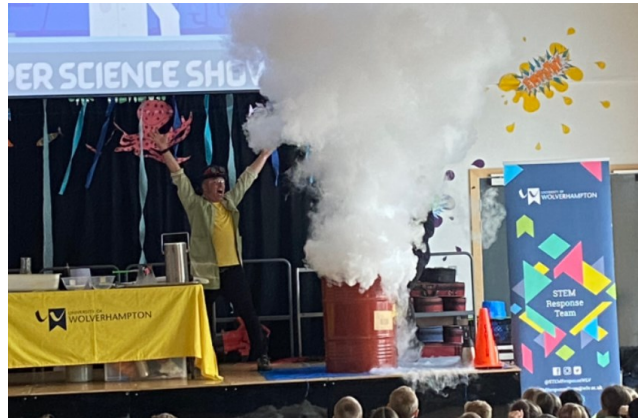
Parking Information:
