The After School Care Provision operates from Christ Church Nursery Building in School Road. Children from Christ Church Federation of Schools attend.

The children are collected from their relevant schools and escorted to the Nursery building these arrangements are included within the schools individual risk assessments.

Spread of COVID 19	Before the children enter the building a member of the ASCP or Nursery Staff will clean the surfaces using surface cleaner and will clean door handles, door contact points, tables, toilet flushes and taps. 	<p>The children will be collected from the relevant site and escorted with the correct pupil to adult ratios to the Nursery building.</p> <p>The infant children will play outside or under the canopy socially distanced until the cleaning is complete.</p> <p>Once inside the building the children will wash their hands using soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds,</p> <p>The children will be kept in two bubble groups- Infant and Junior.</p> <p>They will be allocated designated areas to play and access activities. They will maintain social distancing at all times from children in the other Key Stage.</p> <p>Resources/ Games used by one bubble will either be cleaned or stored in isolation for 72 hours before being available to the other bubble group.</p> <p>Snacks will be eaten at the tables and children will sit socially distanced.</p> <p>Staff will hand out cups and plates and these will be washed in hot soapy water as soon as possible after use.</p>	L	This will be repeated before and after eating, and after using the toilets.	ASCP Staff	Daily

	<p>Staff must serve food to the children. Children must not help themselves eg: from a fruit basket or a central plate of toast.</p> <p>Toileting. Some children will need to pass through the zone of the second group to access the toilet. They should do this without touching anything or coming into close contact with the other group.</p> <p>Juniors will use the adult toilet and the infants will use the small toilets. One cubicle will be allocated for each year group i.e R, Yr1 and Yr2</p> <p>The nursery building will be thoroughly cleaned each morning before it is opened to the Nursery children.</p> <p>Parents will wait outside the lobby when collecting children. Staff will sign the dismissal record.</p>				
	<p>If a child or staff member starts to show symptoms they will need to leave the premises as soon as possible. The child should be seated in the cloakroom area and parents contacted. The staff member supervising will need to wear PPE if a 2m distance cannot be maintained. The parent or staff member showing symptoms must book a COVID test asap and inform the school of the outcome.</p> <p>Parents of other children in the bubble attending ASCP that day should be informed as a precaution to monitor their child. Their child should continue to attend school until the outcome of the test is known. Parents must report to the school if their child starts to show symptoms. The Executive Head Teacher must be informed of any incidents and the HPA will be kept informed.</p>	M	Children and staff should not attend school at all if they show any symptoms. All stakeholders must follow isolation advice provided through track and trace.	All participants
