The last swimming lesson for 4S will be Wednesday 11th December.

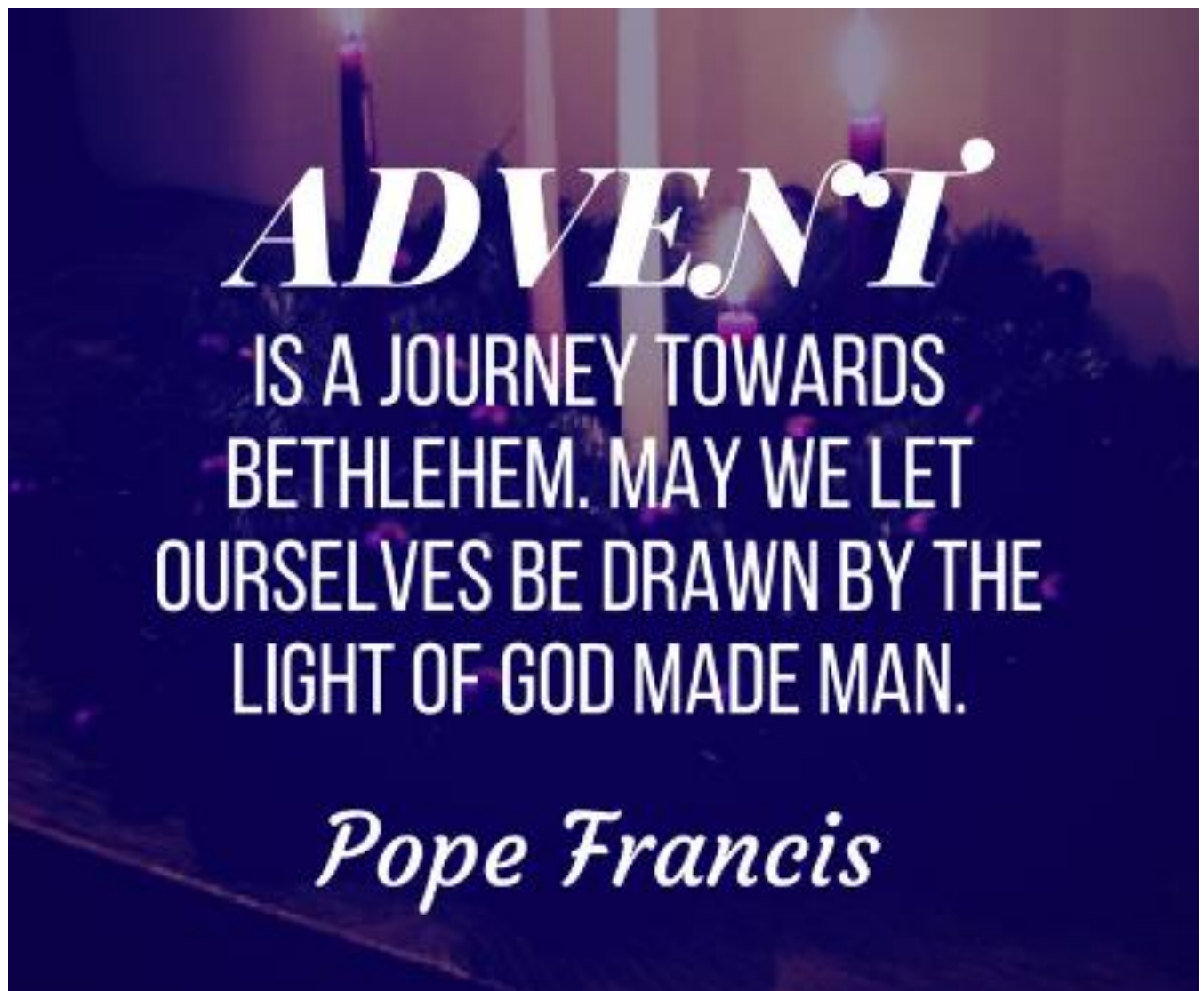
4P will start swimming after Christmas. The first session will be on Wednesday 8th January.
